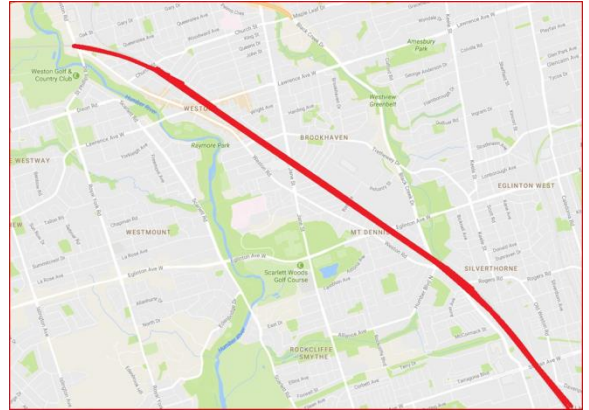


MPP Laura Albanese invites you to join Metrolinx for a Regional Express Rail Update on the Kitchener Corridor

Through its Regional Express Rail project, Metrolinx is increasing the GO Transit service, with the goal of transforming it from a rush hour commuter to a two-way, all-day regional transportation service.

In our community of York South-Weston, improving existing transit options means all-day, two-way service between Union Station and Bramalea Station, and 15-minute service between Union Station and Mount Pleasant Station during morning and afternoon rush hour.

The purpose of the meeting is to learn from Metrolinx about this key transit project, which will include the creation of a fourth track from St. Clair Avenue to Highway 427 with the introduction of electrified trains. The increased service will be accompanied by **new stations intersecting with the Eglinton Crosstown.**

This meeting represents an opportunity for Metrolinx to provide an update on the Kitchener rail corridor.

Topics will include:

- Regional Express Rail
- GO Rail Network Electrification TPAP
- Review of proposed mitigation
- Ongoing work on the corridor"
