### ***Proposal***

This application proposes a Zoning By-law Amendment to permit the construction of a 21-storey (64 metres, including mechanical equipment) residential apartment building with 235 units. The proposed building would have a gross floor area of approximately 17,625 m<sup>2</sup>, which would represent a floor space index of 4.92 times the area of the lot. 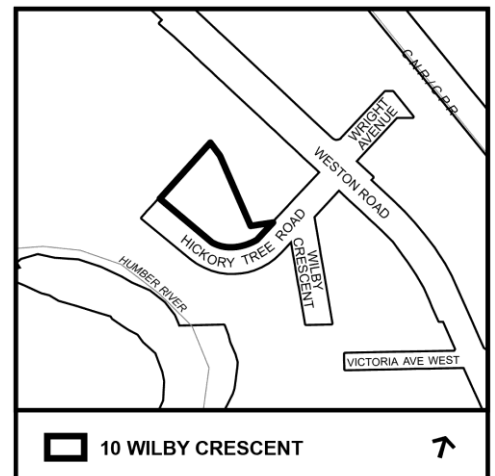
