



The Georgetown South (GTS) Project will provide infrastructure improvements to meet existing GO Transit ridership demand and future growth. It will also accommodate the new Union Pearson Express (formerly known as the Air Rail Link) service between Union Station and Pearson International Airport. This project is one of the key elements of The Big Move.

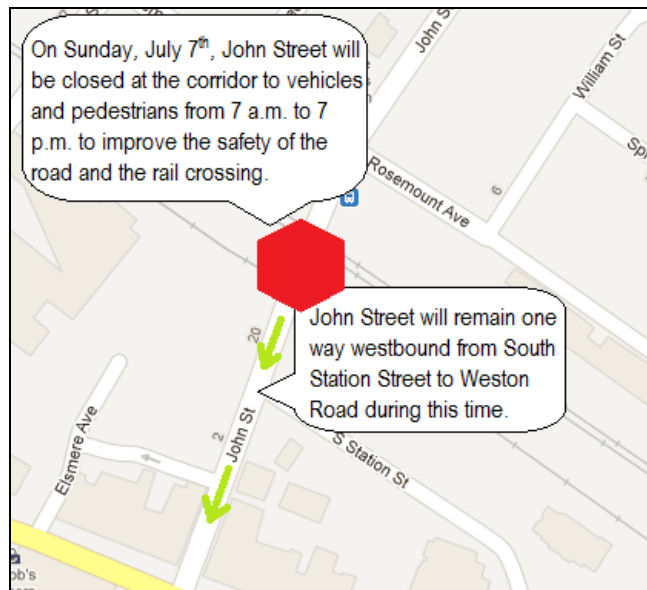
John Street Closure – Sunday, July 7th

What we are doing

- On Sunday, July 7th, John Street will be closed to both pedestrians and vehicles at the corridor
- The old GO tracks crossing John Street have become a tripping hazard and need to be removed and repaved
- At the same time, we will perform maintenance on the new GO tracks, including the replacement of railroad ties
- This work is required to improve the safety of the crossing for pedestrians, vehicles and trains using the GO tracks

How this will affect you

- To complete this work, John Street will be closed at the corridor to both pedestrians and vehicles from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.
- Once work is complete, one way westbound traffic from Rosemount Avenue to Weston Road will be reestablished
- Two way traffic on John Street will be reinstated in late 2013
- Noise will be minimal and limited to back up beepers and maintenance equipment. No work will be occurring in the Weston Tunnel corridor
