

GEORGETOWN SOUTH PROJECT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



The Georgetown South (GTS) Project will provide infrastructure improvements to meet existing GO Transit ridership demand and future growth. It will also accommodate the new Union Pearson Express (formerly known as the Air Rail Link) service between Union Station and Pearson International Airport. This project is one of the key elements of The Big Move.

Weston Tunnel Concrete Pour Prep Begins August 12

What we are doing

- 80% of the Weston Tunnel excavation is complete! The final 20% of the excavation will occur at Church Street beginning in November and then at John Street in May 2014.
- The excavation at the King Street rail crossing is almost complete. We will be pouring concrete continuously to build the Tunnel floor (base slab) and walls in preparation for reopening King Street rail crossing in late October. Access to Weston road along King Street will reopen in late 2014.
- Over the coming months until the end of the year, we will complete ten 18-hour continuous concrete pours to form the floor of the Weston Tunnel. Pours will **begin at 3 a.m. and be completed by 9 p.m.** the same day. Another three pours will be completed in early 2014.
- These pours will happen occasionally and the timing is impacted by weather and construction progress. To stay up to date on the pour schedule please visit gotransit.com/gts and sign up for our mailing list at gts@gotransit.com. Let us know you want information on the timing of the concrete pours.
- These concrete pours cannot be interrupted and need to be completed as one continuous activity to ensure the proper integrity of the concrete.
- Beginning August 12, the next few months will be focused on concrete preparation activities such as formwork and the removal of forms. Some of this work may occur outside of regular working hours (7 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays) in preparation for a concrete pour the next day.



How this will affect you

- Beginning August 12, occasional work outside of our regular working hours (7 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays) will be required to complete activities associated with concrete pouring, such as formwork and rebar installation. These activities are relatively quiet and will have little impact on surrounding neighbours.
